



Ab Osterhaus is an internationally recognized and award-winning scientific researcher and principal investigator for numerous major scientific projects. Prof. Osterhaus is the CEO of Artemis One Health Foundation. In addition, he is Professor of wildlife virology and virus discovery at the Utrecht University. He is also the director of the newly established Center for Infection Medicine and Zoonoses Research at the University of Veterinary Medicine in Hannover, Germany. He is the former head of the Department of Viroscience of the Erasmus Medical Center in Rotterdam, where he guided on a daily basis over 140 scientists in their quest for scientific excellence. Prof. Osterhaus's major accomplishments include the discovery of over 50 new viruses in humans and animals, influential work on the pathogenesis of major infections, and the development of innovative intervention strategies. His work has enabled health authorities including the WHO to combat outbreaks like SARS, MERS, and avian influenza. As Chief Scientific Officer at Viroclinics Biosciences BV, Osterhaus leads effective testing and refining of preventive, therapeutic, and diagnostic tools. He has mentored over 60 PhD students, holds several key patents, and has authored more than 1100 papers in peer-reviewed journals, cited over 45,000 times, and his H index is more than 90.
